There will be a dishwashing station provided near the dog wash area. **Dog Washing:** There will be a dog washing area provided in Hall C.

### USE OF RAMPS

At the discretion of the judge, the following breed may be judged on a ramp: Kerry Blue Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers. Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. (In an emergency situation, an exhibitor does have the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)

### >>> NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS <<<

American Kennel Club Rules and Regulations will govern this event and exhibitors must make themselves familiar with the agreement of the American Kennel Club, referred to on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany this Premium List.

**NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS REGARDING CORRECTION OR CHANGES TO ENTRIES:** The specific changes listed in Ch. 11, Sec. 6 (i.e. sex of a dog, transfers between age specific regular classes and "move-ups" to BOB or BOV) of the Dog Show Rules are the **only** changes to the entries superintendents or secretaries are authorized to make **after closing of entries**. **THIS RULE IS STRICTLY ENFORCED BY THE AMERICAN KENNEL CLUB. PLEASE CHECK YOUR ENTRIES CAREFULLY.** Corrections to entries may be made by the Superintendent prior to the closing of entries if such correction is submitted in writing. Exhibitors are required to report any changes/corrections after closing directly to the American Kennel Club.

*The Bred-by-Exhibitor Class shall be for dogs that are:*

- Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show;*
- Not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show;*
- Individually registered with the American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show;*
- Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show. The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any subsequent classes for which the dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.*

#### BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION

#### **NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES**

*Winners of these classes are eligible to compete in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition. Because competitive classes beyond Best of Breed (Variety) are offered at this show, entries in this class may **not** be spayed or neutered and must meet their individual breed standard requirements.*

Veteran Dog Class - For dogs seven (7) years of age and over.

Veteran Bitch Class - For bitches seven (7) years of age and over.

#### **NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES**

*As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.*

**Brace Class.** For all Terrier breeds. This class shall be for two dogs (a unit) of one breed or variety of breed, irrespective of sex, with at least one common owner and presented in the ring with no more than two handlers. The entry fee for a Brace as a UNIT is \$20.00. Dogs may be entered in another class or for brace class only. The dogs comprising the brace must be named at the time of entry. Full particulars must be given for each dog on an individual entry form. If a dog that is to be part of a brace is entered in another class and entered as part of a brace, specify "Brace Class" in the Additional Classes section of the form. If a dog is not entered in another class, specify "Brace Class Only" in the Dog Show Class section of the form. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be designated as "Brace #1," "Brace #2," etc.

#### **THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE OPEN ONLY TO**

#### **AMERICAN STAFFORDSHIRE TERRIERS**

#### **MINIATURE SCHNAUZERS**

**Stud Dog Class.** For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class. The Get **MUST** be entered in one of the regular classes or Best of Breed (Variety) Competition. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

**Brood Bitch Class.** Same as for the Stud Dog Class, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

**Novice Junior Class** - For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Novice Intermediate Class** - For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Novice Senior Class** - For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Junior Class** - For Boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

**Open Intermediate Class** - For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

**Open Senior Class** - For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

## SPECIAL EVENT

### BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR IN GROUP COMPETITION

**Eligibility:** Dogs/Bitches not defeated in the regular Bred By Exhibitor Class are eligible for Best Bred by Exhibitor competition. Following the individual breed (variety) judging a Best Bred by Exhibitor in Breed (Variety) will be selected by the assigned breed judge from competition between the First Place Regular Bred by Exhibitor Dog Winner and the First Place Regular Bred by Exhibitor Bitch Winner. The Best Bred By Exhibitor in Breed (Variety) would then be eligible to compete for the Best Bred By Exhibitor in Group. If the winner of the Bred By Exhibitor Class is not present for Best Bred By Exhibitor Competition, a second place dog may not compete in its place.

In certain instances there will be an "automatic" Best Bred by Exhibitor in Breed or Group. For example:

- An entry in the Bred by Exhibitor class that is awarded Best of Breed or Best of Winners would automatically be the Best Bred by Exhibitor in Breed.
- If a Bred-by Exhibitor class dog/bitch wins a regular Group First at the show prior to the Bred by Exhibitor Group judging, the Bred by Exhibitor Group will still be held for Second, Third, and Fourth Places.
- The Bred by Exhibitor Group Winner will automatically be Best Bred By Exhibitor in Show.
