Amateur Owner Handler (AOH) Class Eligibility

(Effective as of 1/1/2009) Chapter 3, Section 7 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows "The Amateur-Owner-Handler class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13)."

Bred by Exhibitor Dogs Bred by Exhibitor Bitches

Bred-by Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility

The Bred-by-Exhibitor Class shall be for dogs that are: a) Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show; b) Not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show; c) Individually registered with the American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show; d) Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show. The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any subsequent classes for which the dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

NOTE: Winners from these classes are eligible, if undefeated in another class for Best of Breed Competition.

A Class for Dogs and a Class for Bitches 7 years old or older.

** Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Veteran Dog in the Veteran Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran Bitch in the Veteran Bitch Class".*

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

NOTE: As the judges' decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

*Stud Dog Class *Brood Bitch Class

For DOG or BITCH shown with at least two and no more than four of their Get/Produce. Stud Dogs/Brood Bitches must be entered in the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get/Produce. The owner of the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the Get/Produce. While the merits of the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard for its breed. Get/Produce must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed (Variety) Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class.

**Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class".*

Brace Class: Class is for two dogs (A Unit), irrespective of sex, with at least one common owner and presented in the ring by a maximum of two handlers. Dogs must be entered in another class at the regular entry fee. Dogs entered in the Brace Class must be named in the "Additional Entry" portion of the entry form. Fee is \$19.00 as a unit. If one owner enters two or more braces the braces will be designated Brace #1, Brace #2, etc.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

JUDGE: MRS. CHRISTIE C. SMITH

Novice Junior Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class - For Boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Open Intermediate Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Open Senior Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE. Junior Handlers must put their Junior Handler's number on the entry blank. To obtain a Junior Handler number call the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3595 or E-mail at juniors@akc.org

Notice: Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of the entry form.

By signing the entry form certification is given that the Junior Showman does not now, and will not at any time, act as an agent/handler for pay while continuing to compete in Junior Showmanship.

No Champion of Record is eligible to compete. Sweepstakes will be judged prior to regular classes.

CHAPTER 11, SECTION 1.

No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration.

MAIL ALL ENTRIES WITH ENTRY FEES TO GARVIN SHOW SERVICES, 14622 SE Old Barn Lane, Damascus, OR 97089-9267. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as possible after entries have closed. Confirmation of entry and Judging Program will be sent via First Class USPS mail to the address listed on the Official AKC Entry Form per AKC Rules and Regulations. **E-MAIL CONFIRMATION NOTICES WILL NOT BE SENT.**

IF YOU NEED INFORMATION regarding your entry phone (503) 558-1221. To ensure entries remain confidential until the opening of the event, please use the entry verification space on the entry form by filing in any four numbers of your choice which we can use to verify phone inquiries are being requested by the dog's owner or agent.

AN AKC RECORDING FEE of \$.50 and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only and the AKC Event Service fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2). (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions.)

MAKE ALL CHECKS OR MONEY ORDERS payable in U.S. Funds to Garvin Show Services. The Superintendent assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

RETURNED CHECKS AND INVALID/DECLINED CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Returned checks and invalid/declined credit cards **MUST BE MADE GOOD BEFORE** the dog(s) will be allowed in the ring. Any person that issues a check that is returned for non-payment, or submits payment by credit card that is declined, will be required to pay a fine of \$25 in addition to the entry fees for which check or checks were issued or for charges to the declined credit card. The entry fee plus the \$25 shall then be paid by cash, money order, or cashier's check. Subsequent returned checks or declined credit cards from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.

CONDITIONAL, UNSIGNED, INCOMPLETE, or entries received without fees will not be accepted.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors on entry blanks including wrong information, entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete or for entering the same dog twice. No refunds for duplicate entries.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS or downloaded or photocopies of entry forms without rules and agreement on reverse side of Official AKC entry form and/or not within the official AKC entry size are **NOT** acceptable.

CHANGES, ADDITIONS OR CORRECTIONS to entry forms must be received in writing, by email, or by telegram *prior to the close of entries*. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

gible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry or overpayment of entry fees. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other acts beyond the control of the Club or Superintendent, it is impossible to open or complete an event, no refund of entry fees will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as but not limited to, snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, or the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made. **To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline - 877-252-3229**

NO PRACTICING IN RINGS. DOGS ALLOWED in rings during judging only.

DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club and the Superintendent will not be responsible and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging.

EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE for maintaining clean conditions in and around their crates/set-up.

AKC RULES STATE THAT ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

EXHIBITORS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR VETERINARIAN'S RECOMMENDATION to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

THE BOSTON TERRIER CLUB OF PORTLAND and the Superintendent are not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at this event.

THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show. The exhibitor is also responsible for any damage done by the exhibitor's child.

ALL REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE USE OF THE EVENT FACILITY and all regulations and decisions of the Event Committee will be strictly enforced, including any not recorded in this Premium List.
