The Bred-by-Exhibitor Class shall be for dogs that are: a) Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show; b) Not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show; c) Individually registered with the American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show; d) Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show. The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any subsequent classes for which the dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

NOTE: Winners from these classes are eligible, if undefeated in another class, for Best of Breed Competition.

\*Veteran Dogs, 7 years & under 10 years      \*Veteran Bitches, 7 years & under 10 years

\*Veteran Dogs, 10 years & over                \*Veteran Bitches, 10 years & over

Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Veteran Dog in the Veteran Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran Bitch in the Veteran Bitch Class."

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Note - As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

**\*Stud Dog Class** - For Stud Dogs and at least two but no more than four of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a individually in Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition, or some other Non-regular Class. No Stud Dog or his Get may be shown as a part of another unit. Entry Fee: Stud Dog Only - \$20.00. Stud Dog as an additional class \$10.00.

**\*Brood Bitch Class** - Same as Stud Dog Class, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

"Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class".

Classes will be divided by age and sex. All entries in the sweepstakes MUST also be entered in a Regular Class or for Best of Breed at this show. Entry fee is for each dog and entries shall be made at the same time and on the same entry forms as for the Regular Classes. Indicate "Sweepstakes" and the age division in the space provided for "Additional Classes." Sweepstakes entries may be shown by anyone in good standing with the AKC. Champions of record are eligible to compete. Entry fee is \$10.00.

**JUDGE: MS. CATHERINE DE LA CRUZ**

Veteran Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes and is open to all Great Pyrenees who on the day of the show, will be 7 years of age or older. Champions of Record are eligible. Classes will be divided by age and sex. Each dog or bitch NEED NOT be entered in a Regular Class at the show. All class winners (up to 6) will compete together and the judge will pick Best in Veteran Sweepstakes and Reserve Best in Veteran Sweepstakes regardless of sex. Entry fee is \$10.00 for each dog and entries shall be made on a regular entry form. Indicate "Veteran Sweepstakes" and the age division in the space provided for "Additional Classes." Dogs and bitches which have been altered (castrated or spayed) may be entered. Entries in the Veteran Sweepstakes may be shown by anyone in good standing with the American Kennel Club.

### **VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES**

Classes in the Veteran Sweepstakes will be divided by sex into the following age categories:

Veteran Dogs (7 years & under 9 years)	Veteran Bitches (7 years & under 9 years)

checks were issued or for charges to the declined credit card. The entry fee plus the \$25 shall then be paid by cash, money order, or cashier's check. Subsequent returned checks or declined credit cards from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.

**CONDITIONAL, UNSIGNED, INCOMPLETE**, or entries received without fees will not be accepted.

**OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE** for errors on entry blanks including wrong information, entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete or for entering the same dog twice. No refunds for duplicate entries.

**ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS** or downloaded or photocopies of entry forms without rules and agreement on reverse side of Official AKC entry form and/or not within the official AKC entry size are **NOT** acceptable.

**CHANGES, ADDITIONS OR CORRECTIONS** to entry forms must be received in writing, by email, or by telegram *prior to the close of entries*. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

**ALL PAYMENTS BY CREDIT CARD** will be treated as FAX entries and are subject to fax service fees.

**ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED** in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee, or because the dog is ineligible to compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry or overpayment of entry fees. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other acts beyond the control of the Club or Superintendent, it is impossible to open or complete an event, no refund of entry fees will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as but not limited to, snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, or the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made. **To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline - 877-252-3229**

**AN ADMINISTRATIVE FEE** of \$4.00 per dog per show will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries. Because of the cost of processing no refunds of less than \$10.00 will be issued.

**AFTER CLOSING, NO DOGS** wrongly entered in a class may be transferred to another class, unless specifically allowed for in AKC Rules & Regulations.

**AS SPECIFIED IN CHAPTER 12, SECTION 4** of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the Club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

**THE GREAT PYRENEES CLUB OF AMERICA, INC.** reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

**ALL TROPHIES** must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed or otherwise distributed.

**CLASS CASH PRIZES** will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging is over and the Superintendent's Office advised at once. The Superintendent and the Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the class is over.

**ALL DOGS** must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising pen.

**THERE SHALL BE NO** drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

**NO FLEXI LEADS, HALTI TYPE COLLARS OR PINCH COLLARS IN THE BUILDING.**

**NO PRACTICING IN RINGS. DOGS ALLOWED** in rings during judging only.

**DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING.** The Club and the Superintendent will not be responsible and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

**DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW** only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging.

**EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE** for maintaining clean conditions in and around their crates/set-up.

**AKC RULES STATE THAT ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE** to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

**EXHIBITORS SHOULD FOLLOW THEIR VETERINARIAN'S RECOMMENDATION** to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

**THE GREAT PYRENEES CLUB OF AMERICA, INC.** and the Superintendent are not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at this event.

**THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD** is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the day of the show. The exhibitor is also responsible for any damage done by the exhibitor's child.

**ALL REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE USE OF THE EVENT FACILITY** and all regulations and decisions of the Event Committee will be strictly enforced, including any not recorded in this Premium List.

**ALL PERSONS ATTENDING THIS EVENT** hereby waive any claim for damages against the Club, their members or agents, in the event a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

**DOGS FOUND IN AN UNSAFE** environment, distress or harm's way (for example: left unattended on a grooming table in a noose not attached to a safety release clip) will be removed to safety by Club officials or security personnel. Exposing a dog to an unsafe environment, distress or harm's way will be investigated by the Event Committee.

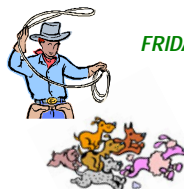
