Amateur Owner Handler (AOH) Class Eligibility

(Effective as of 1/1/2009) Chapter 3, Section 7 of the AKC *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* "The Amateur-Owner-Handler class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13)."

Bred-by Exhibitor (BBE) Class eligibility

The Bred-by-Exhibitor Class shall be for dogs that are: a) Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show; b) Not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show; c) Individually registered with the American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show; d) Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show. The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any subsequent classes for which the dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

RETURNED CHECKS AND INVALID/DECLINED CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Any person that issues a check that is returned for non-payment, or submits payment by credit card that is declined, will be required to pay a fine of \$25 in addition to the entry fees for which check or checks were issued or for charges to the declined credit card. The entry fee plus the \$25 shall then be paid by cash, money order, or cashier's check. Subsequent returned checks or declined credit cards from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a **CASH ONLY** basis.

CONDITIONAL, UNSIGNED, INCOMPLETE, or entries received without fees will not be accepted.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE for errors on entry blanks including wrong information, entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete or for entering the same dog twice. No refunds for duplicate entries.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS or downloaded or photocopies of entry forms without rules and agreement on reverse side of Official AKC entry form and/or not within the official AKC entry size are **NOT** acceptable.

DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging.

EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE for maintaining clean conditions in and around their crates/set-up.
