Amateur Owner Handler (AOH) Class Eligibility

(Effective as of 1/1/2009) Chapter 3, Section 7 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows "The Amateur-Owner-Handler class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13)."

Bred by Exhibitor Dogs Bred by Exhibitor Bitches

Bred-by Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility

The Bred-by-Exhibitor Class shall be for dogs that are: a) Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show; b) Not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show; c) Individually registered with the American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show; d) Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show. **The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog.** In any subsequent classes for which the dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

NOTE: Winners from these classes are eligible, if undefeated in another class, for Best of Breed Competition.

***Veteran Dog Class *Veteran Bitch Class**

A class for dogs and a class for bitches that are 6 years of age or older.

**Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Veteran Dog in the Veteran Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran Bitch in the Veteran Bitch Class."*

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

NOTE: As the judges' decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed (Variety) by virtue of having won these classes.

***Stud Dog Class *Brood Bitch Class**

For DOGS or BITCHES shown with two of their Get/Produce. Stud Dogs/Brood Bitches must be entered in the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get/Produce. The owner of the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the Get/Produce. Stud Dog/Brood Bitch may be entered in the Stud/Brood Bitch Class only or as an additional class. Get/Produce must be entered and shown in a Regular Class, Best of Breed (Variety) Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class. While the merits of the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard for its breed.

**Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.*

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

Offered at the Second (Afternoon) Event Only

JUDGE: MR. MICHAEL STALEY

Novice Junior Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class - For Boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Open Intermediate Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Open Senior Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler identification number on the entry blank. You may obtain your number by calling AKC Event Records Department (919) 816-3776 or email juniors@akc.org.

By signing the entry form certification is given that the Junior Showman does not now, and will not at any time, act as an agent/handler for pay while continuing to compete in Junior Showmanship.

Notice: Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of the entry form.

AN AKC RECORDING FEE of \$.50 and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only and the AKC Event Service fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2). (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions.) All fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

MAKE ALL CHECKS OR MONEY ORDERS payable in U.S. Funds to Garvin Show Services. The Superintendent assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

RETURNED CHECKS AND INVALID/DECLINED CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Returned checks and invalid/declined credit cards **MUST BE MADE GOOD BEFORE** the dog(s) will be allowed in the ring. Any person that issues a check that is returned for non-payment, or submits payment by credit card that is declined, will be required to pay a fine of \$25 in addition to the entry fees for which check or checks were issued or for charges to the declined credit card. CHANGES, ADDITIONS OR CORRECTIONS to entry forms must be received in writing, by email, or by telegram **prior to the close of entries**. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

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compete due to being entered incorrectly. There is no refund of entry fee for duplicate entry or overpayment of entry fees. If because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other acts beyond the control of the Club or Superintendent, it is impossible to open or complete an event, no refund of entry fees will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as but not limited to, snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, or the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made. **To find out about any AKC event cancellations call the AKC Event Cancellation Hotline - 877-252-3229.**

ALL DOGS must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising pen.

THERE SHALL BE NO drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

NO FLEXI LEADS, HALTI TYPE COLLARS OR PINCH COLLARS ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.

NO PRACTICING IN RINGS. DOGS ALLOWED in rings during judging only.

DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club and the Superintendent will not be responsible and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging.

EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE for maintaining clean conditions in and around their crates/set-up.

AKC RULES STATE THAT ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

THE OREGON STATE BULLDOG CLUB, INC. and the Superintendent are not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at these events.

THE WELFARE OF AN EXHIBITOR'S CHILD is assumed to be the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is distinctly understood that exhibitors will exercise control and restraint over their children on the days of the show. The exhibitor is also responsible for any damage done by the exhibitor's child.

ALL REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE USE OF THE EVENT FACILITY and all regulations and decisions of the Event Committee will be strictly enforced, including any not recorded in this Premium List.
