Bred-by Exhibitor Class Eligibility

The Bred-by-Exhibitor Class shall be for dogs that are: a) Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show; b) Not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show; c) Individually registered with the American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show; d) Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show. The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any subsequent classes for which the dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Special Competition: Best Puppy from the Regular Classes, Best Bred by Exhibitor and Best Veteran.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

WINNERS of these classes are eligible to compete for Best of Breed. All entrants MUST meet ALL American Kennel Club requirements for Non-Regular Classes involving single dog entries. NOTE: Any placement other than First in any of these classes eliminates the dog from competing in Best of Breed Competition.

*Veteran Dog Class *Veteran Bitch Class

A Class for Dogs and a Class for Bitches 7 years old or older.

**Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Veteran Dog in the Veteran Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran Bitch in the Veteran Bitch Class at specialty shows.*

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

NOTE: As the judges' decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

*Stud Dog Class

*Brood Bitch Class

For DOG or BITCH shown with at least two and no more than four of their Get/Produce. Stud Dogs/Brood Bitches must be entered in the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get/Produce. The owner of the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the Get/Produce. While the merits of the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard for its breed. The Get/Produce only will be judged. Get/Produce must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed (Variety) Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class. There is no additional entry fee for the Get/Produce as participants with their Sire/Dam in the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Class.

**Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class".*

Novice Junior Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class - For Boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Open Intermediate Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Open Senior Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE. Junior Handlers must put their Junior Handler's number on the entry blank. To obtain a Junior Handler number call the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3595 or E-mail at juniors@akc.org.

Notice: Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of the entry form.

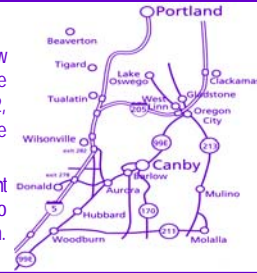

RETURNED CHECKS AND INVALID/DECLINED CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee.
