Bred-by Exhibitor (BBE) Class eligibility

The Bred-by-Exhibitor Class shall be for dogs that are: a) Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show; b) Not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show; c) Individually registered with the American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show; d) Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show. The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any subsequent classes for which the dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

NOTE: Winners from these classes are eligible, if undefeated in another class, for Best of Breed Competition.

*Veteran Dog Class *Veteran Bitch Class

A class for dogs and a class for bitches 7 years of age and over.

** Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Veteran Dog in the Veteran Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran Bitch in the Veteran Bitch Class".*

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Note - As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

***Stud Dog Class** - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not be owner of the Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. Get must be entered individually in one of the Regular Classes, Best of Breed or some other Non-Regular Class.

***Brood Bitch Class** - Same as Stud Dog Class, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

**Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class".*

Brace Class - For two dogs with at least one common owner and presented in the ring with no more than two handlers. The entry fee is \$18. for the Brace as a UNIT. The dogs comprising a Brace must be named at the time of the entry. If a dog which is to be part of a Brace is not in another class, it MUST be entered "BRACE CLASS ONLY." In making entries for "BRACE CLASS ONLY" full particulars must be given for each dog on INDIVIDUAL REGULAR AKC ENTRY FORMS. An entry form for a dog entered in another class and entered as part of a Brace must be marked accordingly in the space provided for "Additional Classes - Brace Class." If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc.

MAKE ALL CHECKS OR MONEY ORDERS payable in U.S. Funds to Garvin Show Services. The Superintendent assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.

RETURNED CHECKS AND INVALID/DECLINED CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. Returned checks and invalid/declined credit cards **MUST BE MADE GOOD BEFORE** the dog(s) will be allowed in the ring. THE PACIFIC RIM MALTESE CLUB reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

ALL TROPHIES must be claimed the day of each show. None will be mailed or otherwise distributed.

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging is over and the Superintendent's Office advised at once. The Superintendent and the Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the class is over.

ALL DOGS must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising pen.

THERE SHALL BE NO drilling nor intensive or corrective training of dogs on the show grounds or premises.

NO FLEXI LEADS, HALTI TYPE COLLARS OR PINCH COLLARS ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.

NO PRACTICING IN RINGS. DOGS ALLOWED in rings during judging only.

DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The Club and the Superintendent will not be responsible and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of breed or class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately thereafter, unless required for further judging.

EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE for maintaining clean conditions in and around their crates/set-up.

AKC RULES STATE THAT ONLY DOGS THAT ARE ELIGIBLE to be shown under the American Kennel Club rules shall be allowed within the show precincts.

THE PACIFIC RIM MALTESE CLUB, INC. and the Superintendent are not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at these events.
