NOTE: An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only and the AKC Event Service fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2). (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions.) An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. (Effective as of 1/1/2009) Chapter 3, Section 7 of the AKC *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* "The Amateur-Owner-Handler class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13)."

Bred by Exhibitor Dog Bred by Exhibitor Bitch
Bred-by Exhibitor (BBE) Class eligibility

The Bred-by-Exhibitor Class shall be for dogs that are: a) Six months of age or older as of the first day of the show; b) Not Champions of record on the date of closing of entries for the show; c) Individually registered with the American Kennel Club as of the date of closing of entries for the show; d) Owned or co-owned by any of the breeders of record as of the date of the closing of entries for the show. The person handling the dog in this class must be a breeder of record and an owner of record of this dog. In any subsequent classes for which the dog from the Bred-by-Exhibitor class becomes eligible, there are no restrictions as to who may handle.

**Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Veteran Dog in the Veteran Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran Bitch in the Veteran Bitch Class*.*

(For Dogs or for Bitches that have received a Junior, Senior, or Master Hunter title in an AKC licensed or member trial.)

NON-REGULAR CLASSES - MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

*As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes, will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed.**

***Stud Dog Class *Brood Bitch Class**

Stud Dog/Brood Bitch and two of his /her Get/Produce entered in this show. Stud Dog/Brood Bitch must be entered in the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Class and shown in the ring with Get/ Produce. Entry fee is \$25 as an original entry or \$18 as an additional class. The owner of the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch need not own the Get/Produce. Get/Produce only to be judged on merit. While the merits of the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch are not be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if he/she has a condition that would require him/her to be disqualified or to be excused under Dog Show Rules, American Kennel Club policy, or the standard for his/her breed. Get or Produce must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition or some other Non-Regular Class. No Stud Dog/Brood Bitch or his/her Get/Produce may be shown as a part of another unit.

**Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class*.*

Brace Class

Class is for two dogs (A Unit), irrespective of sex, with at least one common owner and presented in the ring with no more than two handlers. Dogs entered in the Brace Class must be entered in a Regular or Non-Regular class at this show. Dogs entered in the Brace Class must be named in the "Additional Entry" portion of the entry form. Fee is \$18.00 as a unit. If one

Open Senior Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.



Confirmation of entry and Judging Program will be sent via First Class USPS mail to the address listed on the Official AKC Entry Form per AKC Rules and Regulations. **E-MAIL CONFIRMATION NOTICES WILL NOT BE SENT.**

IF YOU NEED INFORMATION regarding your entry phone (503) 558-1221. To ensure entries remain confidential until the opening of the event, please use the entry verification space on the entry form by filing in any four numbers of your choice which we can use to verify phone inquiries are being requested by the dog's owner or agent.

AN AKC RECORDING FEE of \$.50 and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only and the AKC Event Service fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2). (There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions.) An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. If a dog is entered in more than one class in a Rally event, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3). All fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

RETURNED CHECKS AND INVALID/DECLINED CREDIT CARDS do not constitute a valid entry fee. INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in or over 13 in, but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard), Collies (rough, smooth).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
