If the same dog is entered in more than one class, the highest priced class shall be considered the first entry. Canadian Exhibitors must make fees payable in U. S. Funds. TABULATE CAREFULLY. Because of the cost of processing, no refunds under \$10 will be made.*

NOTE: An AKC Recording Fee of \$.50 and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only and the AKC Event Service fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2). (There are no Recording Fees or Event Services Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions.) An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. If a dog is entered in more than one class in a Rally event, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3). RULES APPLYING TO DOG SHOWS - EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2010

CHAPTER 11, SECTION 1. No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. See <http://www.akc.org/pdfs/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf> for complete detail of the rule change.

Amateur Owner Handler (AOH) Class Eligibility

(Effective as of 1/1/2009) Chapter 3, Section 7 of the AKC *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*: "The Amateur-Owner-Handler class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13)." (continued on page 4)

NOTE: Best Veteran, Best Brindle or Best Puppy competition will be forgone if the Best of Breed is one or more of the above.

Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Veteran Dog in the Veteran Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran Bitch in the Veteran Bitch Class."

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Note - As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

***Stud Dog Class** - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not be owner of the Get. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. Get must be entered individually in one of the Regular Classes or Best of Breed. Entry Fee: Stud Dog Only - \$29.00. Stud Dog as an additional class \$24.00.

***Brood Bitch Class** - Same as Stud Dog Class, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. *"Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."*

Brace Class - For two dogs with at least one common owner and presented in the ring with no more than one handler. Both dogs must be entered in another class. The entry fee is \$24.00 as an additional entry for the Brace as a UNIT. The entry form for each dog entered as a part of a brace MUST be marked accordingly in the space for Additional Classes - "Brace Class". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be so designated, "Brace No. 1", "Brace No. 2", etc.

AWARD OF MERIT

The judge may, at his/her discretion, recall into the ring up to five (5) Bullmastiffs (including Best of Breed & Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed) to receive a Neck Medallion. These Medallions are reserved for those quality animals the judge feels are worthy of final consideration for Best of Breed.

OBEDIENCE TRIAL

For Bullmastiffs Only. No move-ups will be accepted at this trial. "Dog" means either sex. No refund for bitches in season. Qualifying score required for all prizes in regular classes.

Novice Junior Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class - For Boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Open Intermediate Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Open Senior Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler identification number on the entry blank. You may obtain your number by calling AKC Event Records Department (919) 816-3776 or email juniors@akc.org.

By signing the entry form certification is given that the Junior Showman does not now, and will not at any time, act as an agent/handler for pay while continuing to compete in Junior Showmanship.

Indicate "Sweepstakes" and the age division in the space provided for "Additional Classes." Each dog entered must be handled by the owner, by a member of the owner's immediate family or by an amateur handler with exception that professional handlers may handle only dogs that they own/co-own or are the breeder/co-breeder of record and handle without recompense, and all prize money is the property of the owner.

SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES

Dogs and bitches which have been altered (castrated or spayed) may be entered. Entries in the Veteran Sweepstakes may be shown by anyone in good standing with the American Kennel Club.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this show or obedience trial, however such injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of a breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in or over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard), Collies (rough, smooth).

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
