NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

RULES APPLYING TO DOG SHOWS - EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2010

CHAPTER 11, SECTION 1. No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. See <http://www.akc.org/pdfs/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf> for complete detail of the rule change.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

NOTE: Winners from these classes are eligible, if undefeated in another class for Best of Breed Competition.

*Veteran Dog Class *Veteran Bitch Class

A class for dogs and a class for bitches that are 7 years of age or older.

** Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Veteran Dog in the Veteran Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran Bitch in the Veteran Bitch Class".*

Versatile Dog Class Versatile Bitch Class

A class for dogs and a class for bitches who hold an NCA Versatile Newfoundland (VN) title.

Working Dog Class Working Bitch Class

A class for dogs and a class for bitches who hold an NCA WD or NCA DD Title.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

NOTE: As the judges' decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won any of these classes.

**Stud Dog Class **Brood Bitch Class

For DOG or BITCH shown with at least two and no more than four of their Get/Produce. Stud Dogs/Brood Bitches must be entered in the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get/Produce. The owner of the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the Get/Produce. While the merits of the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard for its breed. Get/Produce must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed (Variety) competition, or some other non-regular class at this show.

***Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."*

Brace Class

For two dogs of the same breed, Newfoundland, with at least one common owner. Dogs entered in the Brace Class must also be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed Competition or a non-regular class at this show. Entry fee \$15.00 per unit.

AWARDS OF MERIT

At the conclusion of the regular Best of Breed judging, the judge may at his/her discretion, award up to a maximum of six (6) Awards of Merit. The judge is not obligated to award any Awards of Merit, if he/she feels there are not any dogs or bitches in competition worthy of this award. The total number of Awards of Merit the judge is allowed to award is dictated by the total number of Dogs and Bitches competing in the Best of Breed Competition as listed below. The Newfoundland Club of America, Inc. offers the following to those selected as an Award of Merit: A Medallion. A rosette will be presented to any selected as an Award of Merit.

NOVICE JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

NOVICE SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN JUNIOR CLASS - For Boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

OPEN INTERMEDIATE CLASS - For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

OPEN SENIOR CLASS - For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Quarter page size is 4.5 inches wide by 1.88 inches high.
 - Design your ad in black and white and grayscale your photos (unless you have opted for color ads.)
 - Be sure to include the following information in your cover instructions or email.
 - > The type of format you are sending
 - > The names of the fonts you are using. Include your special fonts on your CD.
 - > Any logos or line art work must be converted to a photo format at 600 dpi.
 - > Do not include any linked graphics.
 - > Preferred photo format is .tiff or .jpeg at 200 dpi. It is important to remember that the resolution available for output of a picture is based on placing the image at 100% of size. No grooming or x-pens allowed in these exhibit halls. Your crates may be placed in designated areas during the judging of your breed, but must be removed upon completion of **your** breed judging.

THROUGHOUT THE BUILDINGS: All chairs, crates and accessories must be placed within designated areas and must not block aisles, door exits or fire extinguishers. Flexi Leads will not be allowed in the buildings.

ALL GROOMING AREAS: Rugs and/or matting will not be allowed. Paper and/or plastic must be used **under** all pens. Please bring your own paper or plastic. Shavings will be offered for sale in the D Hall for use **on top** of paper or plastic.
