BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

NOTE: Winners from these classes are eligible, if undefeated in another class for Best of Breed Competition.

*Veteran Dog Class *Veteran Bitch Class

A class for dogs and a class for bitches that are 7 years of age or older.

**Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Veteran Dog in the Veteran Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran Bitch in the Veteran Bitch Class."*

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

NOTE: As the judges' decision in these classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won any of these classes.

* **STUD DOG CLASS** - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record, in the Best of Breed Competition, but MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class. The Get MUST be entered in one of the regular conformation classes or for Best of Breed Competition. No Stud Dog or his Get may be shown as a part of another unit. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard for its breed. Stud Dog Class fee is \$27 as an original class or \$16 as an additional class.

* **BROOD BITCH CLASS** - Same as for the Stud Dog Class except substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog" and "Produce" for "Get."
** Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."*

BRACE CLASS - Each Brace shall be composed of two (2) Rhodesian Ridgebacks with at least one common owner, to be shown in the ring at the same time. The dogs comprising a brace must be named at the time of entry. The entry form for each dog entered as a part of a brace that is already entered in a regular conformation class or Best of Breed MUST be marked accordingly in the space for Additional Classes - "Brace Class." Entry fee for "Brace" as a unit is \$27.00, if both dogs are individually entered in another conformation class. Alternatively, if a dog/bitch is to be part of a brace but has not been entered in another conformation class, a separate entry providing full particulars must be completed indicating "for Brace Class Only." A fee of \$27.00 (in addition to the entry fee for the brace) must be submitted for each dog entered for Brace Class Only.

AWARD OF MERIT

The judge, at his/her discretion, may award in the ring (excluding the Best of Breed winner) up to 10% (always rounded downward) of the Best of Breed Entries to receive an Award of Merit. The Rhodesian Ridgebacks receiving this award will exhibit qualities that the judge feels are worthy of consideration for Best of Breed.

ELIGIBILITY: The Sweepstakes is open to all Rhodesian Ridgebacks, who, on the day of the show, will be at least 6 months and under 18 months of age. All dogs entered in Sweepstakes must be entered in a Regular Class or for Best of Breed at this show. Professional handlers may handle only their own dogs or dogs they have bred. Champions may compete. Dogs with major points are eligible. Entry fee is \$16.00 in addition to the Regular Entry Fee.
