USE OF RAMPS: Ramps at the sole discretion of the judge, approved breeds may be examined on the ground or on a ramp: Bulldogs. For the Judging of Juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp breeds. Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. *(In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)*

ENTRY FEES

Conformation and Obedience Entry Fees include \$.50 AKC Recording Fee on First Entry and \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee on Each Entry. *If the same dog is entered in more than one class, the highest priced class shall be considered the first entry. Canadian Exhibitors must make fees payable in U. S. Funds. TABULATE CAREFULLY. Because of the cost of processing, no refunds under \$10 will be made.*

RULES APPLYING TO DOG SHOWS - EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2010

CHAPTER 11, SECTION 1. No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. See <http://www.akc.org/pdfs/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf> for complete detail of the rule change.

SPECIAL COMPETITION - To be judged immediately following Best of Breed Competition

Best Puppy from the Regular Classes

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

NOTE: Winners from these classes are eligible, if undefeated in another class, for Best of Breed Competition.

***Veteran Dog Class *Veteran Bitch Class**

A class for dogs and a class for bitches that are 6 years of age or older.

**Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Veteran Dog in the Veteran Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Veteran Bitch in the Veteran Bitch Class."*

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

NOTE: As the judges' decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed (Variety) by virtue of having won these classes.

***Stud Dog Class *Brood Bitch Class**

For DOGS or BITCHES shown with two of their Get/Produce. Stud Dogs/Brood Bitches must be entered in the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get/Produce. The owner of the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch need not necessarily be owner of the Get/Produce. Stud Dog/Brood Bitch may be entered in the Stud/Brood Bitch Class only or as an additional class. Get/Produce must be entered and shown in a Regular Class, Best of Breed (Variety) Competition, or some other Non-Regular Class. While the merits of the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard for its breed.

**Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.*

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

JUDGE: MR. DEAN DICKEY

Novice Junior Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Intermediate Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Novice Senior Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Junior Handlers must include their AKC Junior Handler identification number on the entry blank. You may obtain your number by calling AKC Event Records Department (919) 816-3776 or email juniors@akc.org.

By signing the entry form certification is given that the Junior Showman does not now, and will not at any time, act as an agent/handler for pay while continuing to compete in Junior Showmanship.

Notice: Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on front and back of the entry form.
