RESERVED DAY OR OVERNIGHT PARKING: For information, instructions and forms refer to pages 8 through 11 of the Rose City Cluster Premium List. Reserved Parking reservations will be handled by the JJ's Parking Service staff. Reservation deadline is January 6, 2010.

GENERAL DAY PARKING: General parking is available daily. Enter from the **MAIN GATE ONLY**. The parking fee is \$7.00 per day. Follow the signs to loading and unloading, then return to the general parking area to park. *No exercise pens, grooming or overnight parking in the general parking area.*

GROOMING AREAS AND GENERAL INFORMATION

OPEN HOURS for grooming areas, **Halls A, B and C** - Tuesday, January 19, 2010 and Wednesday, January 20, 2010, 4:00 PM - 11:00 PM Thursday, Friday, Saturday and Sunday grooming areas will open at 6:00 AM and closes Sunday, January 24, 2010 one hour after Best in Show.

EXHIBIT HALLS D and E: Main Exhibit Halls will be open at 6:00 AM and will close each day after Best in Show or completion of specialty/special events. No grooming or x-pens allowed in these exhibit halls. Your crates may be placed in designated areas during the judging of your breed, but must be removed upon completion of **your** breed judging.

THROUGHOUT THE BUILDINGS: All chairs, crates and accessories must be placed within designated areas and must not block aisles, door exits or fire extinguishers. Flexi Leads will not be allowed in the buildings.

ALL GROOMING AREAS: Rugs and/or matting will not be allowed. Paper and/or plastic must be used **under** all pens. Please bring your own paper or plastic. Shavings will be offered for sale in the D Hall for use **on top** of paper or plastic. Clean Drydeck will be allowed under ex-pens. **CRATES:** Where possible, crates must be stacked and crates with dogs left in the building overnight clearly marked with name and phone number of person to contact in case of an emergency. **ELECTRIC OUTLETS** are adequately spaced. No extension cords across aisles and no electric strips or heaters. **DISHWASHING** is not allowed in the restrooms. There will be a dishwashing station provided near the dog wash area. **DOG WASHING:** There will be a dog washing area provided in Hall-C and will close at 2:00 PM on Sunday, January 24, 2010.

RESERVED GROOMING AREA: See page 23 of the Rose City Cluster Premium list for information, instructions and reservation form for Reserved Grooming. **Reserved Grooming** will be handled by the Jack Onofrio Dog Shows, LLC staff.

USE OF RAMPS

Ramps at the sole discretion of the judge, approved breeds may be examined on the ground or on a ramp: Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, and Staffordshire Bull Terriers.

For the Judging of Juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp breeds.

Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed.

(In all but emergency situations, the exhibitor has no recourse. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.)

NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

RULES APPLYING TO DOG SHOWS - EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2010

CHAPTER 11, SECTION 1. No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. See <http://www.akc.org/pdfs/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf> for complete detail of the rule change.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR ENTERING DOGS

TURN TO THE CLASSIFICATION and select the class or classes for which your dog is eligible, then fill in the entry blank completely. **DOGS UNDER THE AGE OF SIX MONTHS** on the day of the Show cannot be entered.

BEST OF BREED (VARIETY) COMPETITION

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

*Winners of these classes are eligible to compete in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition. Because competitive classes beyond Best of Breed (Variety) are offered at this show, entries in this class may **not** be spayed or neutered and must meet their individual breed standard requirements.*

Veteran Dog Class - For dogs seven (7) years of age and over.

Veteran Bitch Class - For bitches seven (7) years of age and over.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Brace Class. For all Terrier breeds. This class shall be for two dogs (a unit) of one breed or variety of breed, irrespective of sex, with at least one common owner and presented in the ring with no more than two handlers. The entry fee for a Brace as a UNIT is \$20.00. Dogs may be entered in another class or for brace class only. The dogs comprising the brace must be named at the time of entry. Full particulars must be given for each dog on an individual entry form. If a dog that is to be part of a brace is entered in another class and entered as part of a brace, specify "Brace Class" in the Additional Classes section of the form. If a dog is not entered in another class, specify "Brace Class Only" in the Dog Show Class section of the form. If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner, the dogs comprising each Brace must be designated as "Brace #1," "Brace #2," etc.

THE FOLLOWING NON-REGULAR CLASSES ARE OPEN ONLY TO

MINIATURE SCHNAUZERS

***Stud Dog Class.** For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed (Variety) Competition, but **MUST** be entered in the Stud Dog Class. The Get **MUST** be entered and shown individually in one of the regular classes or Best of Breed (Variety) Competition. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

***Brood Bitch Class.** Same as for the Stud Dog Class, except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

**Chapter 11, Section 8: of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that "a castrated male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class."*

Novice Senior Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who at the time entries close have not won three (3) first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

Open Junior Class - For Boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 12 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Open Intermediate Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 12 years old and under 15 years old on the day of the show and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

Open Senior Class - For Boys and Girls who are at least 15 years old and under 18 years old on the day of the show, and who have won three (3) first place awards in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition present.

BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR IN GROUP COMPETITION

Eligibility: Dogs/Bitches not defeated in the regular Bred By Exhibitor Class are eligible for Best Bred by Exhibitor competition. Following the individual breed (variety) judging a Best Bred by Exhibitor in Breed (Variety) will be selected by the assigned breed judge from competition between the First Place Regular Bred by Exhibitor Dog Winner and the First Place Regular Bred by Exhibitor Bitch Winner. The Best Bred by Exhibitor in Breed (Variety) would then be eligible to compete for the Best Bred By Exhibitor in Group. If the winner of the Bred By Exhibitor Class is not present for Best Bred By Exhibitor Competition, a second place dog may not compete in its place.

In certain instances there will be an "automatic" Best Bred by Exhibitor in Breed (Variety) or Group. For example:

- a) An entry in the Bred by Exhibitor class that is awarded Best of Breed (Variety) or Best of Winners would automatically be the Best Bred by Exhibitor in Breed (Variety).
- b) If a Bred-by Exhibitor class dog/bitch wins a regular Group First at the show prior to the Bred by Exhibitor Group judging, the Bred by Exhibitor Group will still be held for Second, Third, and Fourth Places.
- c) The Bred by Exhibitor Group Winner will automatically be Best Bred By Exhibitor in Show.

NO PRACTICING IN RINGS. DOGS ALLOWED in rings during judging only.
